Jesmond Neighbourhood Centre is a vibrant and welcoming Centre. The Centre is open to members of the community Monday to Friday from 9am to 4.00pm (Office hours 9am – 2pm), offering Adolescent and Family Counselling (9 to 18 years), SecondBite every Friday from 12noon - 2.30pm, provision of sanitary products and toiletries, shower facilities, Second Hand Shop, Hall and Room Hire, advice and referral to other services for individual support of those with specific needs and much more......

Centre Assistance and Programs held at the Centre:

Adolescent and Family Counselling Program - The Centre provides a range of free confidential services to families with children and adolescents (9-18 years) requiring support, advocacy, counselling and/or referral to meet their unique assessed needs.

Second Bite - every Friday from 12noon until 2.30pm or until goods are exhausted, free bread, fruit and vegetables available, bakery and fresh produce amounts vary from week to week. All welcome, one bag per family, please bring your own bag.

Condom Credit Card Provider - Available from the Admin and Managers Office, the Condom Credit Card project is a friendly, confidential way for people under the age of 25 and are sexually active or thinking about becoming sexually active, to get access to FREE condoms. Drop into the Centre or phone the Centre for more information.

Other assistance at the Centre: Sanitary products available on request, toiletries available on request, Second Hand Shop with donated clothing, shoes, bedding etc for men, women and children at a minimal cost, shower facilities available on request to those in need. Provision of Telstra phone cards, JP Services (by appointment), photocopying, printing and scanning services. Typing of official correspondence (by appointment), typing of Resumes (by appointment), Book Exchange, Free WiFi, Advocacy, a safe place for everyone in the Community.
